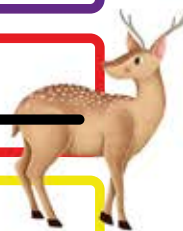


Rearrange the first letter of each answer to spell out a familiar phrase connected with St Mark's Sunday School.
